In order for your greens fees to contribute toward Tour de Cure's charity bike event, all fees must be collected by May 31st. Any registrations received after May 31st will not contribute to Tour de Cure totals.

Golf Outing Rules of Play

1. There are two divisions (A & B). You should choose Division A if your twosome plays a lot of golf and usually scores less than 100 for 18 holes. Choose Division B if you do not play so much, but just want to participate and have fun without worrying about competition for scores.
2. A scramble means that all four team members tee off on each hole and then decide which tee shot they like the best and mark the spot with a tee or ball marker.
3. The other team members pick up their balls and place them within one club length (no closer to the hole) of the marked spot. Each team member hits their next shot from the chosen spot of the prior shot.
4. This procedure is followed on every shot for the remainder of the hole, including putts. The ball should be marked on the putting green also.
5. Putts need to be made within 3 inches of the marked spot (no closer to the hole). The first ball to go in the hole is counted for the team score.
6. If the ball you choose to play is in a hazard (sand, water, etc.), the rough, or out of bounds, you can not drop the ball outside of the hazard or rough even if relief is within one club length away.
7. Each team must use at least 4 tee shots from each player in the foursome.
8. Men tee off from the white tees and women from the red tees.
9. TO SPEED PLAY, bogie is the highest score allowed.

Tiebreakers for the Golf Scramble

In the event we have a tie for 1st or 2nd:

1st tiebreaker: foursome with the most eagles, if still tied go to #2 tiebreaker

2nd tiebreaker: choose one person from each tied team to chip from behind the 18th green, closest to the pin wins the tiebreaker.
